Regulation in the Energy Transition towards a Sustainable Society

Abstract

Over the last 20 years the landscape of energy sectors has deeply changed, reflecting a change in market structure, policy objectives and Institutional governance. The integration of markets at EU level and the transition to a low-carbon and digital economy with increased use of renewable energy sources (RES) are posing numerous challenges to energy regulators and policy makers.

The purpose of this seminar is to address the key aspects of the energy transition and to review some of the major developments in the application of the regulatory tools in the energy industry. This evaluation extends to the recently approved Clean Energy Package, with a focus on the most relevant regulatory issues that will shape the functioning of the electricity markets in the coming years.

Biography

Clara Poletti is Commissioner of ARERA, the Italian independent Regulatory Authority for Energy, Networks and Environment and Chair of the Board of Regulator of ACER, the European Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators.

She has more than twenty years work experience in the energy field. In 1997, she contributed to the start-up of the Italian energy regulatory authority. Since then she has been working in the energy sectors. She is Associate researcher of the Cambridge Energy Policy Research Group. She has been Director of IEFE, the research Centre of Bocconi University on energy and environment and joint academic director of the Centre on Regulation in Europe (CERRE). She has authored numerous scientific articles.
